

Helpful Hints from the Sanitation Department

The City of Foley Sanitation Department collects household garbage, yard debris, bulk items and recyclables. By following these tips you can keep garbage costs down and maximize services for all Foley's citizens.

Special Pickup

- ❖ Properties that require a bulk item or yard debris pickup in excess of 6 cubic yards.
- ❖ Fees for special pickup start at \$400 per load.

Bulk Items

- ❖ Includes furniture, appliances, and other items not typical of household garbage.
- ❖ Bulk items will be picked up on the same day as your yard debris.
- ❖ Bulk Items should be in a separate pile from yard debris.
- ❖ Bulk items should be at least 3 feet apart from your yard debris pile or any other object or structure.
- ❖ Please avoid placing bulk items under low hanging tree branches or power/cable lines.
- ❖ Bulk item pickup is limited to 6 cubic yards per week (approximately the size of a pickup truck bed load).

Yard Debris

- ❖ Includes grass clippings, hedge trimmings, leaves, limbs or trees, no more than 6 inches in diameter and cut to less than 6 feet in length.
- ❖ Yard debris does not include stumps.
- ❖ Yard debris generated by a contractor must be removed by the contractor.
- ❖ Yard debris pickup is limited to 6 cubic yards per week. (approximately the size of a pickup truck bed load)

Household Hazardous Waste

- ❖ The City of Foley does not participate in the pickup or removal of household hazardous waste.
- ❖ Including but not limited to: tires, batteries, used oil, paint and paint thinners, antifreeze, fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, and chemicals, (do not place these items curbside or in garbage or recycling cans) latex paint may be disposed of with regular garbage if the paint can is empty, allowed to evaporate and dry, or is absorbed by adding substances such as cat litter.
- ❖ Baldwin County Magnolia Landfill (251) 972-6878 accepts household hazardous waste during operational hours for a minimal charge.

Household Garbage

- ❖ Please do not place yard debris or bulk items in garbage can, if bulk or yard debris is placed in a garbage can, the can will not be dumped.
- ❖ Please place your garbage can 3 feet from your recycle can, mailbox, or any other object or structure.
- ❖ Please place on the right of way no more than 3 feet from the highway with the handles facing away from the road

Recyclables

- ❖ Recyclables are collected weekly on the designated day of service for your area.
- ❖ Includes empty and rinsed aluminum and steel cans, empty and clean food or beverage cartons, paper such as cereal boxes, newspaper, magazines and mail, flattened cardboard and paper tubes, and plastics such as clean empty kitchen, laundry, and bath bottles and containers.
